



QT X Chevron Gardens Competition – Terms & Conditions of Entry

General

1. The Promoter of the QT X Chevron Gardens Competition (“**Competition**”) is the University of Western Australia (ABN 37 882 817 280) of 35 Stirling Highway, Crawley, Western Australia 6009 (“**Promoter**”).
2. Details on eligibility, how to enter and the prizes for the Competition are set out in these terms and conditions of entry (“**Terms and Conditions**”). By entering into this Competition, entrants are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions.
3. To the extent of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any other reference to this Competition, these Terms and Conditions prevail.

Who can enter

4. Any person over 18 years of age currently residing in the Perth and surrounds, Western Australia, who has fulfilled the requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions is eligible to enter the Competition. No travel expenses will be provided.
5. Employees of the Promoter or its associated agencies and companies, and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter this Competition.
6. UWA or its contractor or agent may, in their absolute discretion, disqualify an entrant for any reason including breaching these terms and conditions, or acceptable or reasonable standards of safety, conduct and respect.

How to enter

7. Eligible persons may enter the Competition by Thursday 7 February at 4:59pm AWST].
8. Entrants must answer the following questions in 25 words or less: What is your favourite memory of an outdoor music experience?
9. Entrants must provide name, phone, email address, postcode and answer to the question via the online form
10. The Promoter has the discretion to deem incomprehensible, illegible, non-compliant and incomplete entries invalid.

Number of entries permitted

11. Entrants may submit a single entry to the competition. Duplicate entries will be counted as one entry.

Prizes on offer

12. The total value of the prize is \$800 AUD.
13. The prize is:
 - 1 x night at QT hotel on Thu 21 Feb
 - Dinner for two at Santini Bar & Grill, QT Hotel on Thu 21 Feb (valued at \$200)
 - 2 x tickets to see Julia Jacklin and Julien Baker
 - 2 x access to backstage tour and sound check for Julia Jacklin prior to the show
 - Beverage vouchers for Chevron Gardens bar up to the value of \$100



14. The prize is subject to the following rules:
- the prize winning entries shall be selected by the Promotor at its absolute discretion (subject to clause 17);
 - the prize must be taken as stated at clause 13 and is non-transferable, non-exchangeable and not redeemable for cash;
 - if the specified prize becomes unavailable for any reason, the Promoter may, but is under no obligation to, substitute a prize of like or equal value;
 - any tax payable as a result of the prize being awarded or received will be the prize winner's responsibility;
 - the Promoter takes no responsibility for the loss of the prize or the inability of the prize winner to use the prize due to incorrect or imprecise delivery details provided by the prize winner, or otherwise; and
 - the Promoter makes no representations or warranties as to the quality, suitability, merchantability of the Prize.
15. The winner acknowledges and agrees that no other payment, cost, fee or prize is payable to the winner by the Promotor other than as expressly stated in clauses 13 and 14 above.

Open, close and draw and publish dates

16. The competition commences on 18 January 2019 at 10:01am AWST and closes on Thursday 7 February at 4:59pm AWST ("**Promotional Period**"). Entries must be received by the Promoter during the Promotional Period to be valid. Entries received after this time will not be included in the Competition and the Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost, misdirected, incorrect or invalid entries.
17. The prize winner will be determined by the Promoter at its absolute discretion if the entrant has provided an answer to the designated question in 25 words or less, as well as provided their name, phone number, email address and postcode.
18. The prize selection will take place by Monday 11 February at 4:59pm AWST.
19. The winner will be notified by phone or email within five business days of the prize selection.
20. The prize must be claimed by the winner within 2 days of notification of winning. Winners will be required to claim their prize by collecting it from the Promotor. Details of where and how to collect the prize will be provided by the Promotor at the time it notifies the winner. The Prize will not be shipped or otherwise delivered to the winner.
21. If the prize is not claimed within that 2 day period, the Promoter may conduct further draws at the same time of day and place as the original draw in order to distribute the unclaimed prize. The winner of any unclaimed prize draw will be notified by phone or email within five business days of the draw and must claim the prize within 2 days of notification of winning in accordance with clause 20. If not claimed, the Promoter may conduct further draws following expiry of that 2 day period, in accordance with this clause 21.

Publicity of Competition

22. It is a condition of entry in the Competition that UWA has the right to publish the name, image, voice, photograph or video of entrants ("Materials") for any matter incidental to the Competition or the promotion or marketing of UWA.
23. UWA may use such Materials in any medium including without limiting on its website or other electronic means, in any reasonable manner it sees fit.

Privacy and miscellaneous

24. The Promoter will collect, use and manage personal information provided in each entry in accordance with its privacy policy accessible online at:

25. All entries become the property of the Promoter once submitted.
26. By submitting an entry, the entrant acknowledges and agrees that it is giving the Promoter permission to use their entry for marketing, publicity or promotional purposes.
27. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, the Promoter (including its officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity) whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Competition, including, but not limited to, liabilities arising from or in connection with:
 - a. any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control);
 - b. any theft, unauthorized access or third party interference;
 - c. any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter;
 - d. any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions;
 - e. any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant;
 - f. redemption of the prize; and
 - g. participation in the Competition

Cancellation

28. UWA reserves the right to suspend, cancel or otherwise close the competition earlier than is stated in these terms and conditions for safety, security, technical failures, weather conditions or any other causes which affect the proper administration, fairness or security of the Competition or the ball pit.
